Please note building and booth space is based on availability.

Exhibitor Information to Remember When Reserving Your Exhibit Space.

Registration: All staff attending the conference and working at your booth must be registered.

Move-In Details and Booth Display Rules: Confirmation of your exhibit space will be emailed in early November. When planning your display, please remember that exhibits must not exceed 8 feet in height at the back and 3 feet in height for sidewalls. For island or end-of-aisle booths (e.g., 20' x 20', 20' x 30'), backdrops should be displayed at 8' high x 10' wide across the middle, with 3' high x 5' wide sidewalls on each side. If your exhibit exceeds these requirements, please contact the conference manager well in advance of the show. Provide photos, size and description of exhibit.

New Rule: Inside and Outside Exhibit Tear Down and Removal of Exhibit: Due to insurance requirements and safety of those attending, all exhibits must remain in place until 2:00 p.m. on Saturday, February 27, 2027. For safety reasons, the tear down and move out of exhibits will commence only after the buildings have been cleared of attendees.

Safety is the key to a successful event. This rule applies to all exhibitors, if you tear down, remove or move out of your booth prior to 2:00 p.m. on Saturday February 27th, you will be penalized \$1,000 early move out fee and or may not be allowed to exhibit the following year. This will be strictly enforced by OLC board. Please make sure your staff attending the show on Saturday understand this new rule and plan your air travel accordingly.

Fire Marshal Inspection: All inside exhibits will be inspected by the fire marshal to ensure compliance with safety regulations. All exhibitors must pass this inspection for the show to open. Please ensure all exhibits are fully set up by 4:30 p.m. on Wednesday, February 24, 2027, for the final inspection. No exhibit booth setup will be allowed on the show's opening day, Thursday, February 25, 2027.

Inside Vehicle/Machinery Exhibits: Inside exhibitors displaying vehicles, trucks, or any fuel-powered machinery must ensure fuel caps are taped or locked, batteries are disconnected, and fire extinguishers are prominently displayed within the booth once the equipment is in place.

Inside Exhibit Removal: All inside exhibits must be removed by 6:00 p.m. on Sunday, February 28th.

Outside Exhibit Removal: All outside exhibits must be removed by 5:00 p.m. on Monday, March 1st.

Transportation: To avoid any issues with the PUC department, please ensure your carrier has the proper transportation documentation as your authorized carrier.

Insurance: Please send a certificate of insurance to the OLC office before January 30, 2027.

Electrical Orders and Details: To receive a discount rate on electrical services, all exhibitors must place their orders by January 30th, 2027. Orders placed on the days of move in will be charged the full electrical rate.

Extension Cords: Only industrial three-pronged extension cords that comply with fire marshal regulations are permitted. Per Fire Marshall Regulations you cannot plug an electrical strip into another electrical strip.

Inside Exhibitors: Please indicate your electrical needs on the exhibitor contract. Note that the electrical charge covers one plug only. If you require multiple plugs/outlets, please indicate the quantity needed on the contract. If you use more than you ordered and paid for you will be charged the additional electrical after the conference.

Outside Exhibitors: Please complete the separate electrical form. For any special electrical requirements, please contact the OLC office for details. Orders placed on the days of move in will be charged the full electrical rate. Outside Exhibitors, please note not all areas have electrical availability.

OLC SHOW RULES AND REGULATIONS

REMEMBER SAFETY FIRST - EXHIBITS MUST BE KEPT IN PLACE UNTIL THE OFFICIAL CLOSURE OF THE SHOW AT 2:00 PM ON SATURDAY, FEB. 27TH.

PLEASE NOTE: Deadline for exhibitors to be listed in the show guide is Dec. 31st. The completed exhibitor contract must be received on or before the deadline. We will continue to sell exhibit space beyond the show guide deadline.

1. All exhibitors at the Oregon Logging Conference must pay the registration fee for everyone attending.
2. All exhibitors must pay the mandatory Advertising/Education/Entertainment Fund fee. Each exhibiting company will be recognized in the Official Conference Show Guide, and their logo will be part of the presentation shown in the main meeting hall. All information must be received prior to the publication deadline.
3. Management reserves the right to change display spaces without advance notice.
4. Your exhibit will be inspected by the **Fire Marshal** according to **Safety Regulations**. **All exhibitors must pass inspection, or the show will not be allowed to open.**
5. **All equipment on tracks must be planked. Repair of damaged areas will be at the exhibitor's expense.**
6. All hot beverages must be purchased through Lane Events Center authorized catering businesses. Call Angi at 541.974.1491
7. You must provide OLC with a **Certificate of Insurance**. The proof of insurance must be provided by your insurance agent and returned to our office no later than January 30th.
8. Oregon is a regulated state — please make sure your carrier has the proper transportation papers designating the company as the authorized carrier.
9. All exhibitors are required to keep their displays within the designated space. Materials found outside the display area will be removed.
10. **Outside Exhibitors are responsible for the cleanup of your exhibit area.** Please remove all planking, bark, logs, sawdust, debris, and decorative items failing to do so you will be charged a disposal fee.
11. The Conference is not responsible for lost or stolen equipment or displays.
12. **Standard Electrical for Inside Exhibit booths** - exhibitors please indicate on exhibitor contract if you will require standard electrical 110–500-watt for 1 electrical outlet plug. The order must be received by January 30th. Orders received after that date will be charged at the full floor order rate of \$200.
13. **Inside & Outside Exhibit areas do not include tables, chairs, carpet, etc. in the exhibit fee.**
14. All inside booth designs must be kept within normal layout guidelines. If you plan to change the layout of your booth, please submit to the OLC office photos of booth setup no later than February 1st for approval.
15. If you provide your own personal pop-up canopy or tent in the outside display area, you will be responsible for any damage it may cause during high winds. Please note: OLC reserves the right to remove the canopy if it appears to be a safety hazard during high winds.
16. **Outside Exhibitors and Special Electrical Orders** must be received no later than January 30th in order to receive discounted electrical rate. Orders received after this date will be charged for the full order rate. See the enclosed form for complete details and pricing or call OLC for more details 541.686.9191.

Show Set Up & Tear Down Schedule

Due to the size of this show and the nature of the equipment on display, organizing a set up and tear down schedule is important for efficiency and safety. **You are responsible for knowing when you can move in and out.** If you have any questions or special requests, call the Conference office at 541.686.9191.

Set Up

The Fairgrounds and buildings will be available to set up displays beginning at 8:00 am on Tuesday, the week of the show. **All displays must be in place by 4:00 p.m., Wednesday, of that week.** Late arrivals must be pre-arranged with the Conference call 541.686.9191. The confirmation letter will designate your move-in time.

Show Schedule – Safety First - Exhibit must stay in place until close of show on Saturday at 2pm.

The Equipment Show is open to Oregon Logging Conference registered attendees and their guests Thursday and Friday from 8:00 a.m. - 5:00 p.m. and free to the public on Saturday, from 9:00 a.m. - 2:00 p.m.

Tear Down – Safety First - Exhibits must stay in place until close of show on Saturday at 2:00 p.m. By Signing this contract your company acknowledges and agrees; all exhibits must be kept in place until closure of show on Saturday, February 27th. **Companies who tear down or move out of exhibit prior to 2:00 p.m. will be penalized \$1,000 early move out fee and/or not allowed to exhibit the following year..**

Outside: Move-out begins Saturday, after 2:00 p.m. **All outside equipment must be completely removed from fairground no later than 4pm on Monday, March 1st.**

Inside: Move-out begins Saturday, at 2:15 p.m. Large truck displays will be assisted with moving-out first to open space in buildings. After that time all other exhibits will then be allowed to move out. **All inside exhibits must be removed from buildings by 6:00p.m. on Sunday, February 28th.**

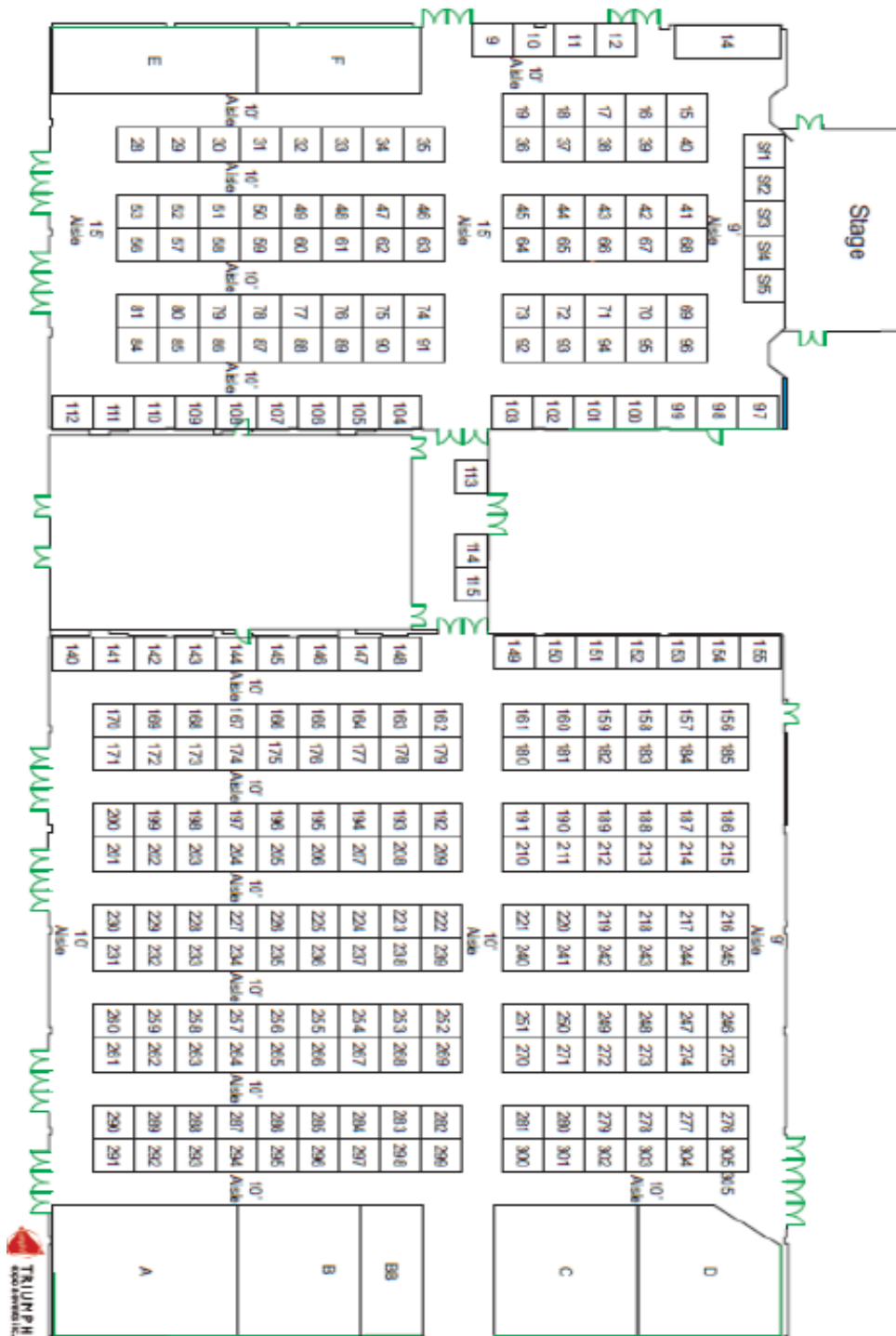

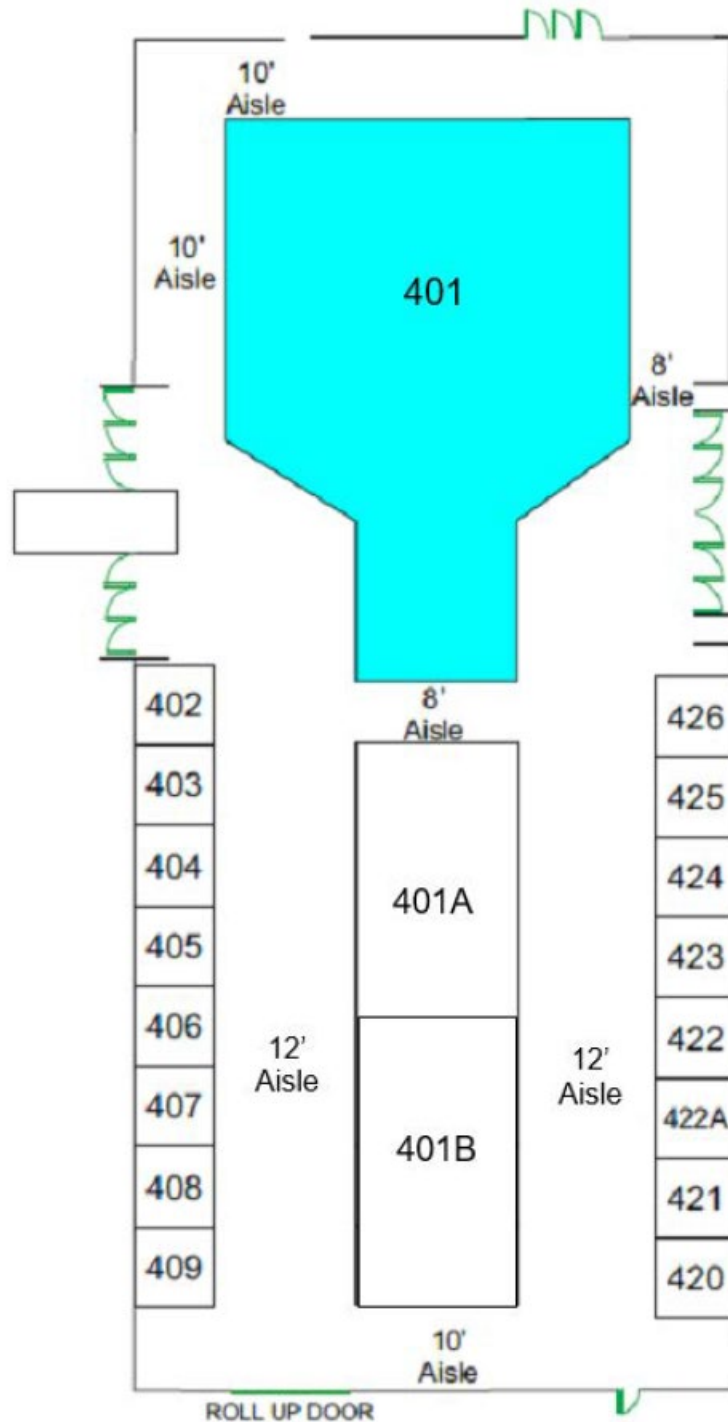

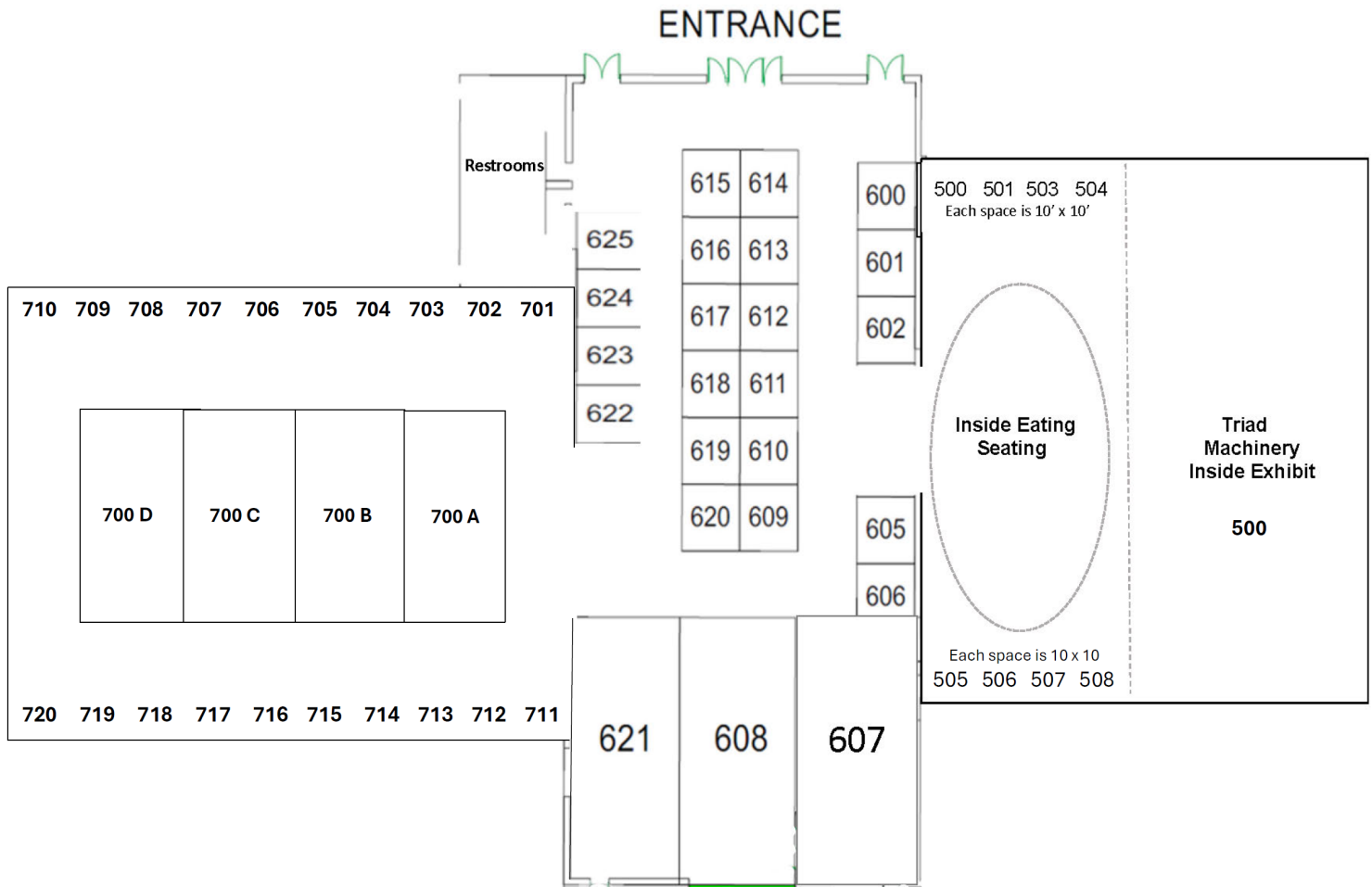

- ♦ All inside fuel powered vehicles / machines are required to have a fire extinguisher. Extinguishers in vehicles are not regarded as “in booth”.
- ♦ Tent layout diagrams must indicate exits and be mailed to the decorator by January 10, 2027.
- ♦ All inside vehicle / gas powered machines **MUST** have fuel caps taped as soon as the vehicle has been placed in booth. Locked caps do not need to be taped.
- ♦ Battery cables **MUST** be taped as soon as the vehicle has been placed in booth.
- ♦ Propane tanks attached to equipment **MUST** be turned off and disconnected.
- ♦ Helium tanks used for balloons **MUST** be chained to cart/stand.
- ♦ All extension cords must be 3-pronged heavy-duty cords. They must be securely taped to the floor. **NO HOME STYLE EXTENSION CORDS**
- ♦ All portions of Display **MUST** stay within designated booth space.
- ♦ Carpet **MUST** stay within designated booth space. All edges **MUST** be securely taped to the floor.
- ♦ All tents must have “no smoking” signs posted at all entrances and exits.
- ♦ All tent “EXITS” must be clearly marked with illuminated signs.
- ♦ All tents must be supplied with a “2A-10BCC” fire extinguisher at each entrance/exit per Fire Marshal rules and regulations.
- ♦ All inside booth designs must be kept within normal booth layout guidelines. If you plan to change the layout of your booth, please submit to the OLC office photos of the booth setup no later than February 1st for approval.
- ♦ **PLEASE NOTE:** If you provide your own personal pop-up canopy or tent in the outside display area, you will be responsible for any damage it may cause during high winds. OLC reserves the right to remove the canopy if it appears to be a safety hazard during high winds.
